Maritime wins 2012 Engineering Excellence Award & Commences Elizabeth Quay Jetty Project

Maritime Constructions was recently announced as **winner of the WA 2012 Engineering Excellence Award** in the category of 'Engineering for Regional Communities' for the work done on the design and construction of Anthon Landing Jetty in Wyndham, WA.
